Notes on billing and t disbursement of funds:	•	If the bill is not submitted by the given deadline, the funding granted may be revoked. In case of severe, well-justified reasons, an extension of up to one year may be requested before the deadline has expired. If no bill is submitted by then, either, the funding granted will be revoked automatically and any payments granted in advance must be repaid. If the actual spend is less than the originally approved spend, the funding will be adjusted and recalculated accordingly. To ensure that the funded projects are realised correctly, the competent State Office conducts random spot checks on at least eight per cent of the projects. In case of false information or noncompliance, the funding will be revoked and the corresponding amount plus statutory interest must be repaid.
